Registered Ultrasound Technician or RN to Be Trained

Job Description

Position Summary

The Ultrasound Technician is responsible for furthering the mission of Pregnancy Center West by providing limited obstetrical ultrasound services to abortion-vulnerable, abortion-minded, and abortion-determined clients. This role supports women facing unexpected pregnancies through compassionate care, education, and life-affirming medical services rooted in Christian values.

Registered Nurses willing to be trained in limited OB ultrasound are encouraged to apply. Training specific to the use of Pregnancy Center West's ultrasound equipment will be provided if needed.

General Duties & Responsibilities

- Perform limited (non-diagnostic) obstetrical ultrasound scans for scheduled and walk-in clients in order to:
 - Confirm intrauterine pregnancy
 - Estimate gestational age
 - Confirm fetal cardiac activity

- Prepare appropriately for ultrasound appointments by collaborating with client advocates and understanding each client's situation and needs.
 - Explain ultrasound procedures in clear, compassionate, and simple terms while answering client questions related to the procedure.
 - Present ultrasound images and preliminary findings to clients and upload findings to the signing physician through the eKYROS client database.
 - Offer compassionate, life-affirming encouragement when appropriate, rooted in medical knowledge and Christian truth.
 - Maintain ultrasound equipment, supplies, and cleanliness of the ultrasound room; order supplies as needed.
 - Complete follow-up communication with clients related to ultrasound appointments and services.
 - Maintain accurate client records, ultrasound notes, and documentation within eKYROS and paper files.
 - Utilize basic computer and technical skills, including interfacing the Mindray ultrasound machine with eKYROS.
 - Collaborate with the Client Services Director regarding scheduling, client care, and concerns that may impact counseling services.
 - Provide feedback to the Executive Director and Client Services Director regarding volunteer development and additional training opportunities.
 - Assist in maintaining and developing policies and procedures related to ultrasound services.
 - Support other staff members and volunteers as needed.
