

Full-time Vice Principal of Academics

Overview

At this time, Saint Ursula Academy is seeking a Vice Principal of Academics who is responsible for the planning, implementing and managing of student services, including discipline and academic achievement. With the Principal, the Vice Principal of Academics coordinates all phases of policy implementation related to academics, instruction, curriculum and discipline. The Vice Principal of Academics assumes the duties of Principal in the Principal's absence. This is a full-time, 12-month administrator who reports directly to the Principal.

Qualifications and Personal Attributes

The Vice Principal of Academics must have a minimum of five years experience as a classroom teacher and three years experience in educational administration or related administrative positions. Supervisory experience is desirable. A Master's Degree in Educational Administration is preferred and graduate coursework and experience in curriculum design is also desirable.

Salary & Benefits

Salary is commensurate with educational experience. Competitive compensation package includes medical, dental and vision insurance benefits, 403(b) retirement plan with a 6% employer contribution after 24 months of service, 3 weeks of paid vacation,

23 paid holidays with additional time allotted for sick days, and a \$50,000 life insurance policy with access to additional voluntary life for the employee, spouse and dependents. Tuition remission is provided for the employee's daughter(s) attending Saint Ursula Academy incrementally up to 100% (after 5 years of service). Employee, spouse, and qualifying dependent(s) are also eligible to receive a University of Cincinnati Business Scholarship for qualifying online classes.
