PRIMARY FUNCTION

The Coordinator of Young Adult Ministry will be responsible for managing a strategic plan of engagement that attracts, connects, and accompanies members throughout their unique discipleship journeys. This position will also be responsible for serving as the staff lead on outreach initiatives in the community. As a staff member of the Office of Catechesis and Evangelization, the Coordinator of Young Adult Ministry will be a key contributor in implementing the Pastor's exciting vision for the Family.

- 1. Plan, coordinate, & facilitate an extensive Young Adult group with regular activities that are both social and spiritual in nature throughout the year.
- 2. Utilize effective means of communicating to young adults the variety of ministry and program opportunities available.
- 3. Develop and maintain a budget approved by the Director of Faith Formation and the Director of Operations.
- 4. Provide ongoing education and consciousness-raising for the broader parish in regards to a vision of young adult ministry and young adult needs.
- 5. Advocate for participation by young adults in the ministries and service organizations of the parish.
- 6. Develop and utilize evaluative tools for all aspects of the ministry.
- 7. Develop strategic plan for engaging parishioners in serving the local zip codes, looking to the corporal and spiritual works of mercy as a guide.
- 8. Serve as the staff liaison to the various outreach ministries of the Family and community partners in the Hyde Park, Oakley, and Madisonville areas.
- 9. Assists engaged couples with date reservation and guidance on the wedding/marriage preparation process
