The ADYE reports to the Pastor and is an active member of a dynamic team that seeks to accompany youth through all stages of the process of evangelization and discipleship.

The ADYE collaborates closely and congenially with the entire staff of St. Joseph Pillar of Families Parishes as well as other family of parishes and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The ADYE must be a model of professional conduct and always represent St. Joseph Pillar of Families Parishes and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati with honesty and integrity.

CREDENTIALS & EXPERIENCE:

1. A practicing Catholic in good standing with strong knowledge of the Catholic Church, including structure and doctrine. Passion for the Catholic faith and sharing it with others.
2. Minimum bachelor's degree in theology, pastoral ministry, religious education or related field preferred and 1-2 years of full-time parish evangelization experience.
3. Experience dealing with youth and Edge curriculum.
4. Strong communication skills. Ability to clearly and accurately articulate information and concepts and command the attention of a wide variety of audiences, both large and small.
5. Team player who is collaborative and enjoyable, pleasant and responsive; someone who builds productive and mutually respectful relationships and engenders trust.
6. Self-starter. Reliable. Employs good judgment. Demonstrated ability to meet deadlines. Attends to duties as expected and communicates any barriers or difficulties as quickly as possible.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Coordinate and run Youth Evangelization at Holy Angels on Wednesday evenings and Sunday mornings August-May.

2. First Sacraments – First Communion and First Reconciliation for Holy Angels Second Grade CCD students.
3. Forming, equipping, training and scheduling all catechist/volunteers at Holy Angels for Grades 1-6.
4. Preparation and implementation of any summer programs for Grades 1-6.
5. Preparation and coordination over the summer for next year's program.
