The ideal candidate will be passionate about capturing the beauty of the Catholic faith through the lens of a camera. This is an opportunity to gain hands-on, start-to-finish experience in editorial photography, work alongside a dynamic team of creatives, and make a tangible contribution to an award-winning magazine and the Catholic Church in western and southwestern Ohio.

The Photography Intern will report to the Editorial Director of *The Catholic Telegraph* and collaborate closely with the entire staff of the Department of Communication & Evangelization. The Photography Intern must be a model of professional conduct and always represent the Archdiocese of Cincinnati with honesty and integrity.

**CREDENTIALS & EXPERIENCE:**

1. A practicing Catholic in good standing with solid knowledge of the Catholic Church. Passion for the Catholic faith and sharing it with others. Open to engaging with stories of faith.
2. Strong interest in photography and visual storytelling. Familiarity with DSLR/mirrorless cameras and Adobe CC editing software.
3. Ability to work both collaboratively and independently, respond productively to coaching, and meet deadlines. Appropriate sense of urgency with strong attention to detail.
4. While not required, preference would be given to candidates who: (a) have experience photographing events or working in a publication/media setting; (b) understand composition, lighting, and photojournalistic techniques; (c) have taken photos in both formal liturgical settings and casual environments; (d) have experience with video recording and editing; (e) understand social media best practices; and/or (f) have graphic design capability.
5. Team player. A person who is collaborative and enjoyable, pleasant and responsive; someone who builds productive and mutually respectful relationships and engenders trust.
