#### **Introduction to the National Statutes**

From the Forward to the Revised Edition:

- o Finally, the *National Statutes for the Christian Initiation of Adults*, the norms which regulate the discipline of Christian Initiation as well as the duties and prerogatives of catechumens, have also been revised to better reflect the experience of the Church in the United States. These statutes, which abrogate the National Statutes of 1988, are fewer in number and include only those statutes which are truly legislative, complementary to the universal law, and unique to the United States. They do not reiterate norms already contained in the ritual text or the universal law.
- It is the hope of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops that this new translation will be an occasion for each of us to live more deeply the promises of our own Baptism and to dedicate ourselves more intensely to the increase of God's holy People.


