54-DAY *Rosary Novena Prayers*

Catholics across the state of Ohio are joining in prayer for the protection of human life and dignity and the defeat of Issue 1 on the Ohio ballot this November.

54-Day Rosary Novenas have been a form of prayer in the Church since the late 19th century. The origin is attributed to a young girl who received a miraculous healing from a chronic illness after praying three novenas. In an apparition, our Blessed Mother specified that the full 54-Day prayer should have three novenas in petition followed by three novenas in thanksgiving. This structure has been embraced by countless people since then as a wonderful way to pray.

The Presentation – Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be

Novena Concluding Prayer: I bind together these lilies with my petitions, and in purity, I lay this bouquet at thy feet.

The Finding of Jesus in the Temple – Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be

Novena Concluding Prayer: I bind together these lilies with my petitions, and in obedience to the will of God, I lay this bouquet at thy feet.
