54-DAY
Rosary Novena Prayers

Catholics across the state of Ohio are joining in prayer for the protection of human life and dignity and the defeat of Issue 1 on the Ohio ballot this November.

54-Day Rosary Novenas have been a form of prayer in the Church since the late 19th century. The origin is attributed to a young girl who received a miraculous healing from a chronic illness after praying three novenas. In an apparition, our Blessed Mother specified that the full 54-Day prayer should have three novenas in petition followed by three novenas in thanksgiving. This structure has been embraced by countless people since then as a wonderful way to pray.

The Apostles' Creed

Novena Concluding Prayer: I bind these blood red roses in the virtue of self-control and I lay this bouquet at thy feet.

The Crowning with Thorns – Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be

Novena Concluding Prayer: I bind these blood red roses with humility and I lay this bouquet at thy feet.

The Carrying of the Cross – Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be

Novena Concluding Prayer: I bind these blood red roses with patience in adversity and I lay this bouquet at thy feet.

The Crucifixion of Our Lord – Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be

Novena Concluding Prayer: I bind these blood red roses with love of my enemies and I lay this bouquet at thy feet.
