Gabrielle Bouscaren Grant for Continuing Catechetical Education Policies and Guidelines

- Grant applies only to those degree or certificate programs, conferences or workshops that, in the determination of the CNE, manifest a <u>clearly catechetical dimension</u>: i.e., Catechetic, New Evangelization, Theology, Theology of the Body, Pastoral Ministry.
- 2. Such courses or conferences <u>may not</u> be associated with the Archdiocesan Catechetical Institute (Vocare) or other Archdiocese of Cincinnati-hosted events, activities or workshops.
- 3. Grants may be applied only to such programs, certificates courses/conferences/workshops themselves, not to administrative fees, costs, psychological profiling tests, transportation, room and board or living expenses associated therewith.
- 4. The grant money will be payable to <u>sponsoring Catholic institutions</u> for specific courses/conferences not to individuals or a generic program (i.e., LPS 401: Sacramental Theology, not MA program in Theology). Applications who are high school religion teacher seeking to complete their certification must take a course appropriate to the high school religion teacher certification requirements.
- 5. Employees of the Central Offices of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati are not eligible for Bouscaren grants.
- 6. Priority will be given to those candidates who document financial need and manifest the following characteristics:
 - Have a professional goal to be a Catechetical Leader (principal, CRE/DRE)
 - Desire to complete certification (CRE/DRE, High School catechist)
 - Are committed to meeting the catechetical needs of the marginal (i.e., migrant workers)
 - Have the demonstrated support of the pastor or religion department chairperson/high school principal as establish by the letter of recommendation
 - Whose grant application furthers the above catechetical criteria.
