## **ACTION REQUIRED**

### **VOCATION POSTER 2019**

Each parish, college/university and Catholic high school in the archdiocese should have received two copies of the 2019 Vocation Poster in November. Please display the poster prominently in your church and/or school to support vocations to consecrated life. If somehow your parish or school was missed, please contact Maria Reinagel at 513.263.6683.

### **OHIO MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE**

On January 1, 2020, the Ohio minimum wage will increase to \$8.70 per hour. The minimum wage increase is the result of a constitutional amendment passed by voters in November 2006. The amendment requires the Ohio minimum wage to increase on January 1 of each year by the rate of inflation. The increase is tied to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the prior 12 month period as of September 30, 2019. As a result of this increase, please make sure that none of your employees is paid less than \$8.70 an hour beginning January 1, 2020.

### **OHIO & FEDERAL COMBINATION POSTER**

All locations, regardless of size, are required to post the Federal & State Poster. It is your responsibility to have this poster displayed in a public location.

### **EASTER VIGIL START TIME**

The *Roman Missal* specifies that the Easter Vigil "must take place during the night, so that it begins after nightfall...". In the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, **the Easter Vigil should begin no earlier than 8:45 p.m.**, and preferably at 9:00 p.m.

### **REQUEST FOR MASS COUNTS ONE SUNDAY PER MONTH IN 2020**

We request that each parish collect Mass counts one Sunday per month in 2020. Please keep this data at your parish office; the Office of Parish Vitality and Mission will then request it from you in June and December.
