In this final period of preparation for the Sacraments of Initiation, the three **Scrutinies** are to be celebrated with the Elect on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent using the Cycle A readings. (cf. RCIA, 20, 146). Please note, "The bishop may dispense from one of them for serious reasons or, in extraordinary circumstances, even from two" (RCIA, 20). In other words, these are not optional rites and should be celebrated in the context of the community of faith.
