SPECIAL COLLECTION - 2018 DISASTERS

We are all aware of the devastating impact of Hurricane Florence in the Carolinas. Torrential rains have caused catastrophic flooding. Thousands of homes, businesses, and churches have been severely damaged or destroyed.

Given the patterns of recent years, it is reasonable to expect much more unpredictable weather and an increasing number of natural disasters. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked that all dioceses take up a special collection for the humanitarian, long-term recovery, and Church needs arising from these storms. The Archbishop asks that this special collection be taken up in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati on the weekend of October 13-14. Please mail the collection to the Finance Office.

CHURCH INVOLVEMENT IN POLITICAL ISSUES

With the upcoming November elections, the constant advice of the USCCB and the Chancery is to be unusually scrupulous by **avoiding any activity** that could be perceived as supporting any political party and/or its candidates, including the signing of petitions promoting political issues. Just because a political party, a candidate, or a group of supporters says that some proposed activity or statement of support is appropriate does not make it appropriate. A perception of a violation could cost thousands of dollars in attorney's fees. In addition, the not-for-profit designation could be lost, which would have a chilling effect on offerings and donations. CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Just a reminder that the <u>Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statements</u> are due by December 1, 2018. Each year responsible individuals who hold decision making or policy setting positions or who purchase equipment, supplies or other goods, must sign the form.

The Department of Human Resources will be using a different protocol when dealing with the Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement. In the past, Disclosure Statements that had potential conflicts of interest have been sent to the Director of Human Resources. Going forward, when a parish or parish school employee or non-parish school employee identifies a potential conflict of interest, the disclosure statement should be given to the Pastor, Principal or his/her designee to

address. Certainly, if the Pastor or Principal would like assistance in addressing the potential conflict, we encourage them to contact Human Resources. All other Disclosure Statements must be kept in a confidential file (at your location) under lock and key.
