The Catholic Telegraph has asked if the deacon community would again serve as the primary contributors for the online Lenten Reflection series. We have taken on this task in the past and it has


been very successful. This year they've asked if deacon wives and/or couples would also consider contributing a reflection, in addition to deacon contributions. The basic format is:
