ARK Topics are taken from content in the leading religion textbooks (2-8), and the USCCB high school framework (9-12). Of course, much knowledge of the Catholic faith is passed on not through textbooks, but through the culture of the Catholic school. Therefore ARK includes questions in all grades that draw on knowledge gained from habits of discipleship such as the Mass, the Liturgical Year, Christian anthropology, the Use of Scripture, Virtue, and Prayer.

Please note that ARK replaces 20% new questions each year to ensure test integrity, this list of topics is based on last year's test and is subject to change.
