

My dear Deacon Brothers, Men in Formation, Wives and Widows,

Have you ever read the text of the Proclamation issued by President George Washington when he promulgated the first Thanksgiving be established on November 26, 1789?

"Whereas it is the duty of all Nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey his will, to be grateful for his benefits, and humbly to implore his protection and favor-- and whereas both Houses of Congress have by their joint Committee requested me to recommend to the People of

the United States a day of public thanksgiving and prayer to be observed by acknowledging with grateful hearts the many signal favors of Almighty God especially by affording them an opportunity peaceably to establish a form of government for their safety and happiness.

Now therefore I do recommend and assign Thursday the 26th day of November next to be devoted by the People of these States to the service of that great and glorious Being, who is the beneficent Author of all the good that was, that is, or that will be-- That we may then all unite in rendering unto him our sincere and humble thanks--for his kind care and protection of the People of this Country..."

The cost is about \$2000 which includes everything, air travel, lodging, meals and transportation. The trip is arranged and sponsored by Crispaz (Christian for Peace in El Salvador). Our faith and friendships grow with these visits, particularly with the families of the 150 children for whom we provide scholarships. Besides the time we spend with them, we will learn about the country and visit sacred sites there including celebrating Mass in the chapel where St. Oscar Romero was assassinated in 1980. Ordination Dates for 2024




