### **Annual Reports Are Due by January 31**

Annual reports for the year 2023 for all "Active" status deacons are due to the Office of the Diaconate by January 31, 2024. The link to the online report can be found on the Secure Login section of the Diaconate pages of the Archdiocesan website. Please click this link to go to the Secure Login page. The password to enter the page is DEACONCOMMUNITY in all capital letters. Once in the Secure Login area, click on the Continuing Formation Report box and fill out the form. It will be e-mailed directly to the Office and a copy will also be sent to you.

Remember, **to be in Good Standing** in the Archdiocese, each Active status deacon must submit an annual report, complete 10 hours of Continuing Formation each year, attend a retreat yearly, and be current with quarterly bulletins in the SafeParish system. Senior Status deacons are not required to submit an annual report, complete continuing formation or attend a retreat, but must be current in SafeParish.

# <u>Very Good Commentary on Fiducia Supplicans</u>



No doubt, you all have heard news reports and social media commentary over the highly controversial Declaration *Fiducia Supplicans* (On the Pastoral Meaning of Blessings) issued on Monday, December 18 concerning the possibility of blessing same sex unions and other irregular situations. Hopefully you

have read the text for yourself (<u>available here</u>). The Chancellor's Office issued a statement on Tuesday, December 19. (If you did not receive it, please let me know.)

On Wednesday, December 20, I heard a very good assessment of the implications of the document by Fr. Phillip-Michael Tangorra, a canon lawyer, on the SonRise Morning Show on our very own Sacred Heart Catholic Radio AM 740 & 910. It is perhaps the clearest commentary I've heard or read on this declaration. I am providing a link to the SonRise Morning Show Dec 20, 2023 archive of that discussion here. 
