




Who are we?




Who are we?





Who are we?

We invite, welcome and support each other to discern and respond to God's plan for each of us so that we may all experience the peace, joy and fullness of life that Jesus promises.



Witness to Jesus Christ's love for us by reflecting the same love and compassion to all God's people.


DISTINCTIVELY CATHOLIC

Through baptism, Catholics become part of the Mystical Body of Christ; they do not merely **go** to Church, they **are** the Church.




